FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

The parable of the Sower

Friends, Jesus uses parables which are very special kinds of stories; they are fictitious stories describing real life situations. Every parable therefore invites the listener to pass a judgment on the situation described in the story, which is in fact one's own situation.

Through this Sunday's parable of the Sower, Jesus invites us to consider our life and see how we accept the seed (God's Word) each day of our life. If our hearts are open and if we treasure it in our hearts and are willing to do everything required for His Word to transform us, then our life will bear fruits, fruits of love and goodness. The seed grows where there is openness to the word (faith), trust in its power (hope), and a readiness to go out of oneself (love).

Are we open to God's Word which has the power to transform us? Do we treasure it in our hearts and are our actions always guided by the Word of God?

Matthew also wrestles with the failure of the words of Jesus to produce the desired effect in the disciples. Maybe even our very favorite seed, our best, most self-sacrificing good deed, our smartest remark, our greatest insight, will end up on the path, or even fall among thorns. But that is not ours to control; it is not ours to worry about. This means that in imitation of Jesus, we do not focus on the result of our action. We focus solely on the action that we must perform and leave the harvest to the Lord of the Harvest. Wish you all a wonderful weekend.



The Nebraska Catholic Conference worked diligently for the passage of LB753, known as the Opportunity Scholarships Act, which was signed into law earlier this Spring. With it, Nebraska became the 49th state to enact some form of school choice plan. Now, opponents of school choice in our state are mounting a petition drive to obtain a ballot referendum seeking to overturn LB753. Unfortunately, their information is, at best, misleading, Bishop Hanefeldt is inviting us to respectfully decline to sign this petition.

Furthermore, if you have already signed this petition and wish to withdraw your signature, go to www.keepkidsfirstnebraska.com, scroll down to the last of the frequently asked questions where you can print off the "Affidavit for Removal of Name from Petition." School choice is better for everyone. LB753, signed into law by Governor Pillen, is a step in the right direction.


