FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Size Doesn't Matter!

Friends, Have you ever been told that you are too small to do certain things? I can remember that when I was ten or eleven I wanted to ride roller coasters but the attendant

said I was too small and needed to grow a little bit more before I could ride it. It really made me sad because I wanted to ride that roller coaster, then and there.

Look at the story Jesus has told us about the mustard seed which is one of the smallest of all the seeds in the world. They may look really small but they grow into a very large plant. Jesus teaches us three important lessons from this parable: 1. Size doesn't matter to God. You will never be too small for God and, as a matter of fact, you're just the right size for God to use you right now. God is more concerned with what you're becoming, not with what size you are now. 2. God wants you to grow.

There is one way that God works in every person's life. Do you know what it is? God always starts small and builds from there with your collaboration. 3. There is nothing beyond your ability. Even though you might be small; God can still do great things through you. David wasn't much older or larger but God used him to defeat a giant, Goliath.

With God in our lives, there is nothing that is impossible. A human life, beginning with an infinitesimally small cell, has potential for greatness and goodness. So, the next time you feel like you're too small to do anything big or important, remember the mustard seed and know that you're just the right size for God.

What we are is God's gift to us and what we become, with guidance of God, is our gift to God.



SM Parish Council Meeting July 13, 2023. All 18 trees have been removed from the Church and surrounding area. \$10,000 was sent to St. Raphael's in Haiti. Two teachers are planning to come to our area to learn English. At this time, communication is poor with no English speaking people. Fr. Antony has offered to continue to work with our Haiti mission. The Parish Center flooring will be replaced. The Church's west sidewalk still needs to have some work done. Drainage and safety are main concerns. A Ten Commandments monument will be sponsored by the parish family. There are some issues with the stained glass windows, the contractor has been contacted. There is some cracking in the south and west Church walls and steeple shutters need to be examined.
