FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Friends of Families in Faith:

Last Sunday, we all reflected on two great people in the Bible, the great prophet Elijah, and the head of the apostles, St. Peter; how they began their spiritual journey and eventually came to understand who our God was.

This Sunday, the Canaanite woman, in her personal choice, began her spiritual journey and overcame all obstacles with her tremendous faith and courageous act: "Have pity on me, Lord, Son of David! My daughter is tormented by a demon." No woman would ask men anything in public. It was highly against the culture of Jesus' time. In her case it was much more strongly felt because she happened to be a Canaanite. Nevertheless, she went ahead walking over the troubled waters. She even met with an obstacle from Jesus, "It is not right to take the food of the children and throw it to the dogs." Her faith was severely tested by seemingly harsh words of Jesus. It is hard to face good people, turning us down - Isn't it?

Nothing could shake her faith. She continued the journey with unshakable faith and courage – a lesson to be learned by all of us. She did not react. Rather she, humbling herself, responded courageously, "Please Lord, for even the dogs eat the scraps that fall from the table of their masters." What an amazing faith, courage, and humility! It changed even the Lord of the universe. Jesus said, "O woman, great is your faith! Let it be done for you as you wish".

We have the power to change everything. What we need is: faith, courage, and humility. Do we have them? Are we Christians, ghetto minded? Do we have the perseverance of faith like the Canaanite woman? *Fr. Lawrence*
