Searching for New Life

Friends of Families in Faith, The parables of the "Treasure and Pearl" teach us not to let the opportunities go by, when the kingdom of God is offered to us. First, we need the spiritual antenna to sense the opportunity; next the commitment to grab it, whatever the cost. The point in the first two parables seems to be that the dawning of the kingdom calls to reflection on one's values.

In the parable of the Net, a large net is used to catch fish of every kind. There is no sorting out of the fish at the time of their being caught. It is only after the net is full and drawn ashore that the sorting takes place. The good fish are kept and the bad are thrown away. In the parable of the house holder, both the new and old are affirmed. However, the old, which is valuable, is presented in a new light and therefore seen in a new way. We might become so used to doing things in a particular way that we are unwilling to change even if someone shows us a better way of doing the same thing.

Friends, these parables are calling us to newness of life. Let us pray for the wisdom to recognize the kingdom of heaven in our midst and intensify our efforts to pursue it starting right now. There is no time to lose, and we will obtain the immeasurable joy that only comes when we embrace the kingdom of God as we recognize it. Fr Lawrence
