FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK RANSFIGURATION

Transfiguration is Transforming in Love"

Dear Families in faith, In the face of the transfigured Jesus, the disciples saw not only who Jesus was, but what humanity is created to be. That was perhaps the most overwhelming KOFOUR LORD dimension of the entire experience. It's easy enough to look at a heavenly being and bow down and offer

to build tents or temples. But that wasn't Jesus' message.

Jesus told Peter, James, and John that it was time to go down from the mountain. It was time to return to his ordinary way of revealing who God is. They still needed time to understand not only that he was the image of God, but that they were called to be the same. What they saw and thought of as a glimpse of eternity was really nothing more than a revelation of the deepest meaning of their everyday history.

Over a hundred years ago, the Blessed Metropolitan Anthony, a Russian Orthodox prelate, preached about this feast saying that the goal of the Lord's revelation was to persuade his followers that they too are to shine with the beauty of God's love. He said that people longed for the Christ who would reveal fearsome majesty while Jesus offered them simple humanity which has more potential for glory than we can ever imagine.

Blessed Anthony told his listeners to look around them, to see people who had been transformed. He told them to notice in their faces, their eyes, and their tone of voice that which is infinitely attractive. In essence, Anthony tells us "Listen to them! Learn from how they have learned to live as God's beloved and are empowered to love as Jesus loved us." The message of the Transfiguration is not apocalyptic. Instead, he shows us what every human being can become when open to transforming love. Fr Lawrence


