FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Crossing triumphantly the 'Deserts' of Life

Dear Parishioners.

In the Gospel of today, we hear: "The Spirit drove Jesus out into the **desert**, and he remained in the desert for forty days, tempted by Satan.' (Mk. 1:12)

Lots of circumstances in our life can be deserts: a crisis of faith, a life-threatening or serious illness, the death of a loved one, separation from a partner, loss of reputation, rejection of a friend, or an unbelieving spouse. During such critical experiences, we could become confused, frustrated, angry and question God's love and providence. As Satan did with Jesus in his desert experience, he will flash in our minds too all kinds of things that will appear to be good, attractive, and wonderful to destroy our fellowship with God and steal away our destiny and blessings. If we are to come out of our 'deserts' triumphantly, we must follow the example of Jesus.

How did Jesus defeat Satan - the evil?

First, he fully **submitted to God's Will** for his life. Second, he fully **trusted the word of God**. The only weapon Jesus used was **the Word** (Mt. 4:1-11). That should tell us that the only way the enemy's lies can be defeated is by way of the truth of the Word of God.

If we are going through the desert experience, there is no need to despair. We only need to trust God who is at work in our life. In the dark night of faith, we let God lead us on our journey to the promised Land even if we get there circuitously by the way of the desert. The experience of the desert opens up to a deeper and more profound faith in God and in His goodness even as we wander through the lonely desert. **The desert is not the end of the story**, because Scripture says that God always brings His people out of the desert to the promised Land: "**God brought us out** from wilderness in order **to bring us in**to the Promised Land" (Dt. 6:23).


