Fourth Sunday in Easter - Jesus, the Good Shepherd FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK Dear people of God,

The fourth Sunday of Easter is traditionally known as Good Shepherd Sunday, reflecting the image of Jesus, tenderly carrying a sheep on His shoulders. This depiction highlights His compassion and care. Jesus says, "My sheep hear my voice, and I know them and they follow me...and I give them eternal life."

To experience Jesus as our Good Shepherd, we need to be mindful of three things. First, we must hear His voice. Just as a shepherd leads by voice and the sheep trust and follow, we too must remain close to Jesus to discern His voice amidst the noise of the world. Second, a personal relationship with Him enables Him to know us intimately. The Risen Christ knows each of us personally. As our late Pope Francis said, "Jesus knows our strengths and our defects, and is always ready to care for us, to heal the wounds of our errors with the abundance of His grace. This is why He is the Good Shepherd – He is concerned about His sheep, healing their wounds and ailments. Third, following the Shepherd involves not just listening to His voice but also aligning our actions with His will. As Jesus said in the sermon on the Mount, it is not enough to merely speak; we must do the will of the Father. Recognizing the voice of our divine Shepherd calls us to respond to His loving call and follow Him closely.

When faced with challenges, Jesus the Good shepherd reassures us of His presence and support. The poem "Foot Prints in the Sand" beautifully illustrates this: When you see only one set of footprints, it was then that I carried you." As witnesses of Jesus' self-sacrificing love, we are called to proclaim His love by our witness. Trusting in Him, the followers have no reason to fear, for He will wipe away every tear from their eyes. Yours in Christ. Fr. Lawrence
