FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK Sixth Sunday in Easter Dear people of God,

In today's Gospel, we hear Jesus speaking to his disciples: "Whoever loves me will keep my word, and my Father will love him, and we will come to him and make our dwelling with him." Jesus is asking that we permit the Blessed Trinity to come and dwell within us. This is a stunning request. It tells us that our first priority should be directed toward God Himself.

How does one show hospitality to God? How do we make God "at home" within us? How can we communicate to God that He is "highly valued" by us? Jesus tells us how: we are to keep His word, to follow His teachings. To keep His word, we must know His word. This takes discipline and effort on our part. We must make the study of Scripture and Church teaching a priority in our daily lives.

If we want our parish to be a place of genuine Christian hospitality, we must be sure that our own hearts are hospitable dwelling places for the Blessed Trinity. On this Memorial Day weekend, we remember and give thanks for those who have given their lives in order to make this country, a peaceful dwelling place for all of its citizens. Imitating their spirt of sacrifice, let us also through our sacrifices, make our hearts as God's dwelling place. Then our smiles and words, our greetings and ministries will radiate with the warmth of God's love. And our parish family will become at least a little bit like Heaven on earth. 
