FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK Dear people of God,

In the gospel of today, we have a very touching passage wherein we see that three times Jesus asks Peter the same question: "Do you love me?" And three times. Peter replies in the affirmative, but with the third time he seems to be troubled. Although Peter denied Jesus three times, Jesus does not write him off, or reject him, rather he trusts and entrusts with him a great task of leading the Church and continuing God's mission in the Church.

Like Peter, all of us have betrayed Jesus one way or another. But Jesus doesn't give up on us either. Just like he accepted Peter in his vocation and God's mission after his fall, so, Jesus wants always to reestablish us in our baptismal vocation and mission. Jesus wants to ask us, "Do you love me more than these? Do you love me more than everything else?

He wants to send us the Holy Spirit to instill in us the same gift of courage that He gave to Peter on Pentecost. He wants to help us to show our love for Jeus by the way that we cast our nets for others. Despite our miseries, sinfulness, brokenness, and unworthiness, Jesus invites us to follow him and is ready to entrust with us new responsibilities of leading the Church. His love of each one of us is unconditional.

What is our response to his invitation? Like Jesus, are we ready to forgive the wrong doings of our brothers and sisters and thus becoming the true heralds and witnesses of his unconditional and forgiving love in today's fast changing world. Yours in Christ. Fr. Lawrence
