FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK Trinity Sunday
Dear people of God,

A good illustration of the Trinity comes from the world-renowned scientist Henry Morris. He notes that the entire universe is Trinitarian by design. The universe consists of three things; matter, space and time. Take away any one of those three and the universe would cease to exist. But each one of those is itself a trinity.

Matter = mass + energy = motion. Space = length + height + breadth. Time = past + present + future. Thus, the whole universe witnesses to the character of God, who made it. (Psalm 19:1)

God, as Trinity is not a human invention, but a divine revelation. He has revealed three distinct functions carried on behalf of his love for us. The work of creation is attributed to the Father, the work of redemption is attributed to the Son, and the work of sanctification is attributed to the Spirit. Though they are different functions, they stem from the same source. God.

We celebrate Trinity Sunday, not to remind ourselves of three persons in one God, a mystery which is beyond human comprehension, but to remind us of God's continuing action among us and His call to live a life of communion. What makes this communion different, complete, and perfect is the absence of 'l'. All that the father has, is given to the Son, and all that son has, is taken by the Spirit and is given back to the Father, and the presence of the Spirit is that 'Love' relationship between the Father and Son. This mutual self-giving of 'Trinity' has no 'I', but 'We'. They exist for the other and not for self. We are created to model this communion to overcome selfishness, hatred, pride, envy, jealousy, and greed. When we let love rule us, Trinitarian communion is lived in our families, communities and our world. Our family too has this trinitarian aspect: father, mother and children. Today as we celebrate the fathers' day, let us remember all Yours in Christ, Fr Lawrence our fathers with gratitude and love. God, bless us all...
