Luke 14:25-33

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear people of God,

This Sunday's Gospel passage presents a rich tapestry of theological themes centered around humility, and hospitality. Jesus is dining at the house of a Pharisee. This sets the stage for Jesus to challenge traditional notions of social status, honor and religious observance. Jesus observes how quests at the table look for places of honor, and he adequately made use of this situation to teach about humility. He advises choosing the lowest place at the table so that when the host notices and invites you to a higher place, you will be honored in front of everyone. This teaching subverts the world's hierarchy of status and honors, emphasizing the value of humility and self-effacement.

"Humility is not thinking less of yourself, it is thinking of yourself less." (C.S. Lewis)

This passage calls us to reflect upon our own lifestyles and attitudes with regard to Humility and Exaltation. Jesus teaches that the true honor comes, not from seeking recognition and status for oneself, but from humbly serving others and allowing God to exalt us in due time. It challenges our cultural and personal obsession with self-promotion and encourages a spirit of humility and service. The parable highlights the importance of radical hospitality, especially towards those who are marginalized or overlooked by society. It calls us to extend love and welcome everyone to our space and time, sharing the resources. It challenges us to reevaluate our priorities and live in accordance with our values of love, compassion, and inclusivity that characterize the reign God. Yours in Christ, Fr. Lawrence


